

Ovariohysterectomy (Spay) Instructions!

Your dog has been spayed today, this means that we have put your animal under anesthesia and gone into her abdomen to remove her ovaries and her uterus. She has internal sutures and external glue or sutures. It is important that she rests for the next 14 days after this surgery, she is not allowed to lick at the incision site nor should any of your additional pets be able to do so. An elizabethan collar is available to keep her from licking at the incision site. No Jumping! A pain injection was administered at the time of surgery and will last 24 hours. Additional pain medication and antibiotics are strongly recommended for the comfort and health of your pet. You should leash walk and cage confine him for the next 14 days for optimal healing. No food or water until the morning after surgery. Please call us with any concerns.
